### Janamashtami Celebrations in Santa Maria

## Circle time

The week started with children reflecting on what they would like to appreciate about each other. Every child got a chance to speak about the quality he/she appreciates in his/her friend. This helped them to not only enhance their understanding for each other but also connect to what qualities they appreciate in Krishna.

#### **Science Observation**

Butter being Krishna 's favourite food item, children decided to find out how it is made. They understood the process of making butter through a simple step by step demonstration done in the class. They not only saw the process but also understood the reaction between the ingredients when treated in a specific manner.
